To minimise the spread of infection through nasal discharge, by ensuring that nose wiping is carried out in an efficient way and according to recommended guidelines.

Implementation

The Kinder Garden will ensure that at all times the educators/staff wash their hands after wiping a child's nose, as this will reduce the spread of colds.

It is not necessary to wear gloves when wiping a child's nose. If you do wear gloves, the educator/staff member will use disposable tissues to wipe the child's nose. The educator/staff will remove the glove by pulling over the hand covering the tissue at all times.

Children will be taught to wipe their own nose using disposable tissues and disposing of them in a bin.

Children will wash their hands after wiping their nose.

The Approved Provider/Nominated Supervisor will ensure that this policy is maintained and implemented at all times.
