- Parents/Guardians are welcome to visit at any time.
- Parents/Guardians are invited to make suggestions and contributions to the children's program, service menu, surveys, policies and procedures including enrolment and orientation.
- The expertise of families is recognised and parents/guardians share in decision making about their child's learning and wellbeing.
- Parents/guardians and other authorised family members are invited to share aspects of their culture with the educators, other staff and children: such as craft, cooking, music and language experiences (Such as favorite stories, stories from home cultures, special skills, talents or even bathing a new baby).
- Special activities will be arranged throughout the year to promote family and community participation in the service's activities.
- Parents are also invited to participate in the daily routine such as assisting in craft activities, special language activities and morning/afternoon tea.
- There will be an annual "Meet the Teacher" night at the beginning of each year to provide families the opportunity to meet the educators and discuss the program and their child.

**The Approved Provider/Nominated Supervisor will ensure that this policy is maintained and implemented at all times.**
